New Charges/Non-Alternative to Revocation

- 1. Complete the Referral Form
- 2. Complete releases of information for:
 - a. Wood County Criminal Justice
 - b. Wood County Human Services
 - c. Department of Corrections (only if individual is on probation/parole)
- 3. E-mail all forms to: criminaljustice@woodcountywi.gov

Alternative to Revocation

- 1. Complete the ATR Referral Form
- 2. Complete releases of information for:
 - a. Wood County Criminal Justice
 - b. Wood County Human Services
 - c. Department of Corrections (only if individual is on probation/parole)
- 3. E-mail all forms to: criminaljustice@woodcountywi.gov

^{*}Referrals for open cases/new charges must have approval from the Wood County District Attorney's office.

What happens once a client is referred to drug court?

- 1. The Drug Court Coordinator/Case Manager will review the referral for any disqualifying factors, such as violent offenses, residency issues, or District Attorney approval. If any issues are identified, you will be contacted.
- 2. The client will be scheduled to complete a risk/needs assessment with the Drug Court Coordinator/Case Manager. Clients must score as moderate to high risk to qualify for the program.
- 3. The client will be scheduled to complete an AODA assessment with Wood County Human Services. (If a client has had an AODA assessment within one year, they may not be required to complete a new assessment. This requires approval from the treatment provider). Clients must have an identified substance use disorder to qualify for the program.
- 4. The referral will be presented to the Drug Court Team during a staffing meeting, which occurs every Monday.
- 5. The team will vote on acceptance into the program. This usually occurs immediately after the presentation, unless there are further issues to discuss.
- 6. The final decision on acceptance or denial will be sent to the referral source via e-mail.
