Hamerla: Reported on Blue Green Algae concerns, number of beetles that were raised to take care of purple loosestrife plants, problems with giant hogweed.

Cisar: Discussed purple loosestrife, and the boat wash station for Big Green Lake and the Zebra mussel study on the Chain of Lakes in Waupaca County.
