



Improvement Thinning

The area behind these signs is undergoing an improvement thinning. An improvement thinning is an intermediate treatment in which less desirable trees are removed to improve the growth and vigor of the remaining trees. Trees considered for removal include undesirable species, trees of poor vigor, poor quality, injured and unhealthy, and to improve spacing. Primary goals of this thinning include: improvement of future stand composition, structure, health, quality, as well as maintain or improve aesthetic qualities within the park.
