- Central Staking \$182 per corner
- 90 West with Borderland Surveying \$159 per corner

Kevin recommends to accept the bid from 90 West with Borderland Survey as the primary for \$31842 (\$159 per corner). They have requested a minimum of one reference per person by one week from today. If that doesn't follow through, Kevin recommends accepting the Central Staking bid for \$36,050 (\$182 per corner).
