Sheriff Becker let the committee know the department is selling pins and patches to raise money for Deputy Dean's wife who has breast cancer.

Sheriff Becker discussed an upcoming meeting with Human Resources regarding contract negotiations with the Deputy Sheriff's Association.

The Committee reviewed the Wood County Rescue report. The Committee discussed the length of the report and would like to only see calls for service and training.

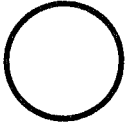

WHEREAS, after consultation with the Emergency Management Director and the Communication Coordinator, the Public Safety Committee determined it was in the best interest of the County to have the Communication Coordinator position report directly to the Committee and not be a subunit of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Committee voted at that time to make this change, effective January 1, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the Committee voted at their May 13, 2019 meeting that the title of this position be changed to Communications & Cyber Director and that the job classification title also be changed to Communications Director.

WHEREAS, at the June 18, 2019 meeting of the County Board, a motion was made to refer this action back to the committee for review and to bring forth a resolution in order for the Board to make the final determination on the above mentioned reorganization.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY RESOLVES to, approve the action of the Public Safety Committee in the reorganization of the Communications Department, with the Communications & Cyber Director reporting directly to the Public Safety Committee.

1. WARNING & COMMUNICATIONS

- a. Talked with many residents in Saratoga regarding flooding that is occurring.
- b. A release of an unknown amount of sewage was reported to the DNR on July 10, 2019 in the Township of Rudolph on Flick Creek.
- c. A spill of approximately 200 gallons of wastewater occurred on July 11, 2019 at the Verso Mill in 4th Avenue in the City of Wisconsin Rapids.
- d. A spill of approximately 100 gallons of wastewater occurred on July 21, 2019 at the Verso Mill on 5th Ave in Wisconsin Rapids.
- e. A spill of 1337 gallons of wastewater occurred on July 20, 2019 at the Verso mill on 4th Ave. in the City of Wisconsin Rapids
- f. A suspected spill of an unknown amount of Sulfuric Acid occurred on July 25, 2019 at the Verso Paper Mill. A caller reported a release of dilute sulfuric acid due to a compromised underground sewer at the facility. Caller also stated that the cause of the sewer line breaking is unknown at this time. No actual material was ever discovered.
- g. Monitored Tri-County test well for ground water levels in the Town of Saratoga.
- h. Opened up the Wood County EOC for several days for July 20th storm.
- i. Opened shelters in Saratoga and Wisconsin Rapids for residents in need of charging medical devices.
- j. Worked with Salvation Army to provide lodging.
- k. Worked with townships and municipalities to obtain initial damage assessments.

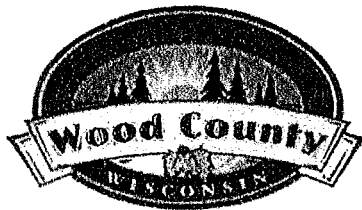

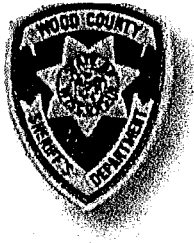

Collectively the Wood County Sheriff's Department, Wisconsin Rapids Police Department, Marshfield Police Department, Pittsville Police Department, Grand Rapids Police Department, Nekoosa Police Department and Port Edwards Police Department report issuing 68 traffic citations for speeding on Wood County Roadways.

- 117 written warnings for various moving and equipment violations

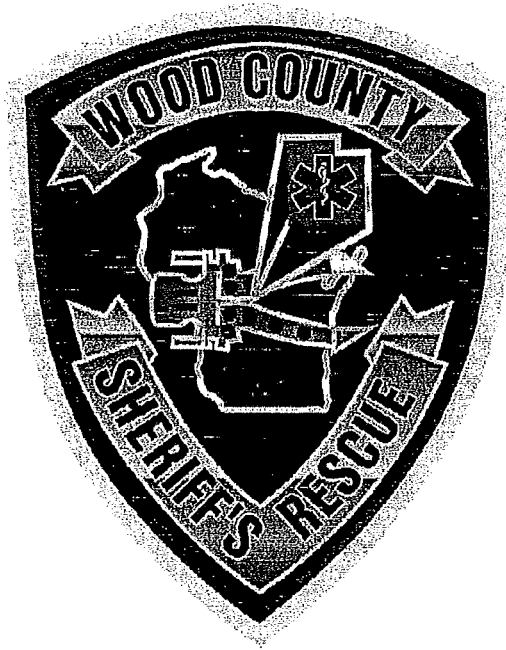

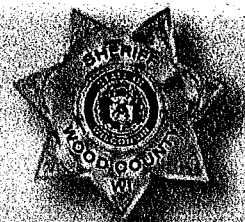

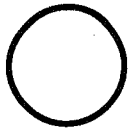
